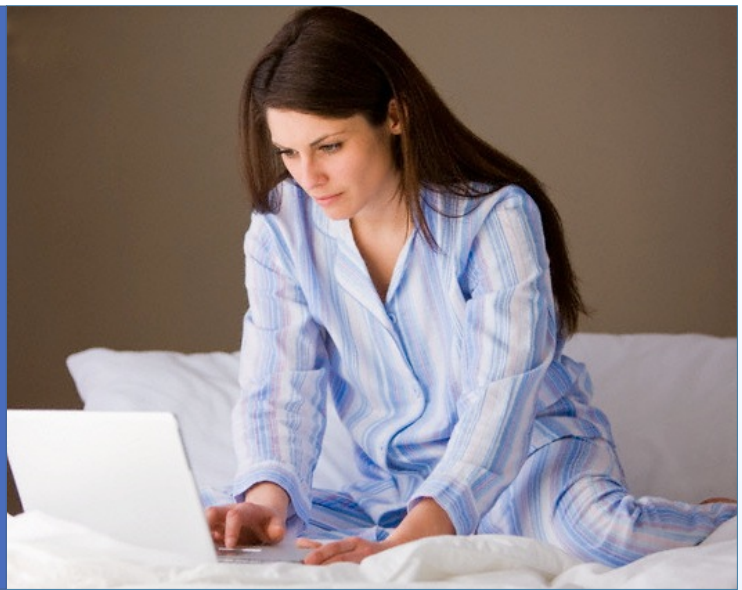

Looking for an easy way to fit a little professional development into your busy schedule? You can earn contact hours or Ashland credit in your pajamas!

Dublin City Schools' Department of Academics and Student Learning is offering free professional development via completion of online modules focused on *Learning About Autism Spectrum Disorders* and/or *Learning About Assistive Technology*. It's PD you can do in your pajamas!

Complete Online Modules between December 1 and June 1

The online modules are provided by OCALI (Ohio Center for Autism and Low Incidence). Two types of modules are offered. Autism Internet Modules (AIM) focus on evidence-based practices and interventions for children with autism. A sampling of topics includes: structured teaching, visual supports, transitioning between activities, and many others. Assistive Technology Internet Modules (ATIM) provide information to address AT assessment, supports and services, transition planning and more. AIM and ATIM modules feature case studies, instructional videos, pre- and post-assessments and a glossary of key terms. At the end of the course, participants will submit pre- and post-assessments, along with a list of completed modules. You also have the opportunity to write reflections.
