

# Gifted, Creative, and Talented

## Online Endorsement & Graduate Certificate Cohort Program at Reduced Graduate Tuition Rates.

The University of Cincinnati offers reduced tuition rates for PreK-12 teachers to enhance their current credentials through Professional Development programs. Cohort programs are offered online, and students are expected to meet with their classmates (cohort) once per semester, face-to-face, in an area near to them. Cohort programs are typically completed in one year (three semesters, 18 credit hours) and are offered with potential for additional scholarship opportunities to further reduce tuition costs.\*

\*Cohorts are based on enrollment. Contact PD office to see if there is a cohort available in your area.

## Gifted, Creative, and Talented Endorsement / Graduate Certificate Program

The Ohio Gifted, Creative, and Talented Endorsement / Graduate Certificate program is designed for licensed teachers who are interested in becoming specialized in teaching gifted students from preschool through grade 12 (PK-12). The program satisfies the coursework requirement for the Ohio Department of Education's Gifted, Creative, and Talented Endorsement and meets CAEP (formerly NCATE) standards.

\*Students seeking to add the Gifted, Creative, and Talented Endorsement to a teaching license in a state other than Ohio are advised to contact the licensing bureau in that state to determine the applicability of the University of Cincinnati endorsement/certificate courses.
